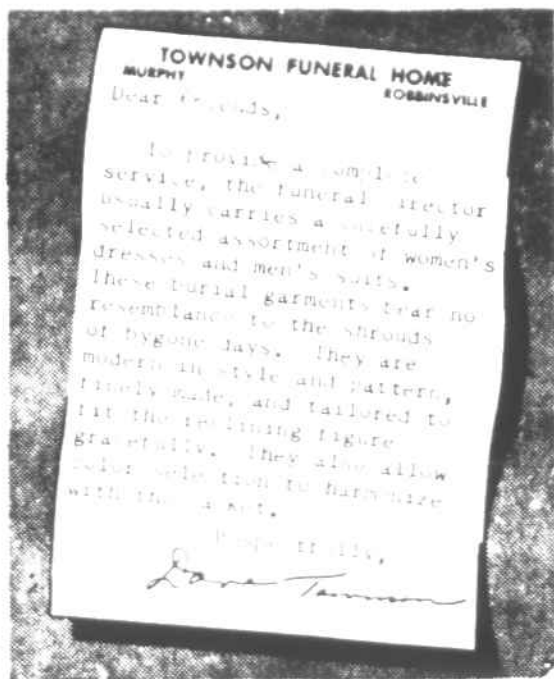

## Bradley-Hembree Vows Exchanged

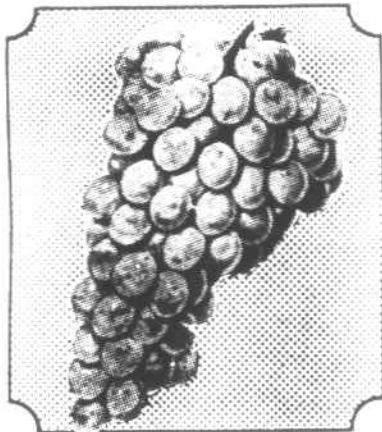

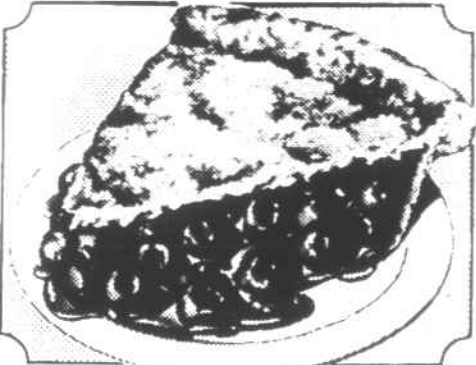
