

## Farm Land In County Decreases, Corn And Beef Production Up

The total number of farm | North Carolina and U, S, De- | in farm land in 1967 compared land and the number of acres harvested in Cherokee County showed a decrease from 1966 to 1967, but there was a substantial increase in the number of acres of corn harvested and the number of beef cattle.

The figures are contained in the Preliminary 1968 County Commissioners Farm Census Summary compiled by the

partments of Agriculture, Crop Reporting Service.

The number of persons living on farm tracts in the county declined one percent to 4,896 people. The number of persons living on farms and working 100 days or more in offfarm jobs increased from 1,-101 to 1,228.

A total of 113,716 acres were

to 115,275 in 1966.

Harvested cropland declined from 7,212 acres to 6,249. Corn harvested for grain was the big gainer. Acreage increased from 2,756 to 3,378. Corn harvested for silage was up from 66 to 102. There were substantial declines in acres of tobacco and soybeans.

Beef cattle increased from 2, 247 head to 3,315. Dairy cattle remained virtually unchanged, up to 991 from 988.
