ASCS Vote Scheduled

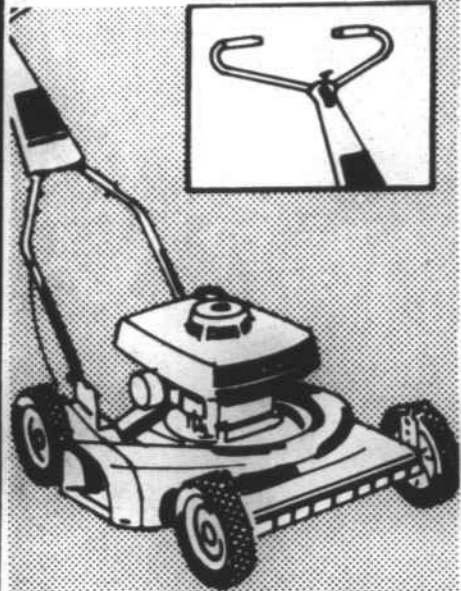
An election will be held in September in Clay and Cherokee counties to select community and county ASCS committeemen.

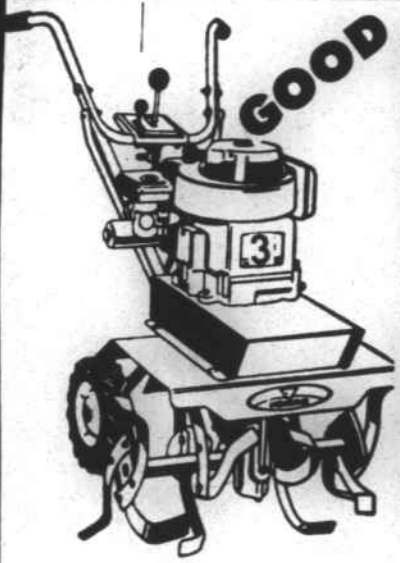

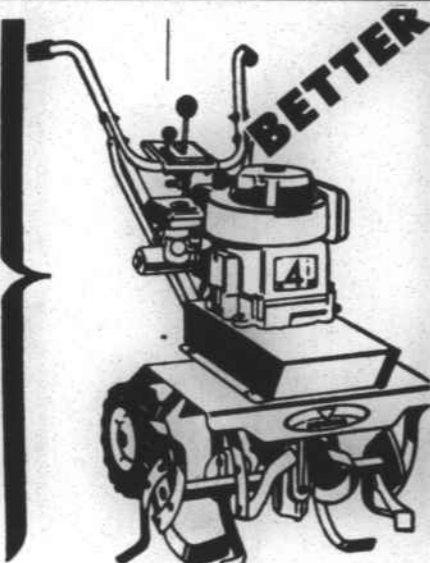

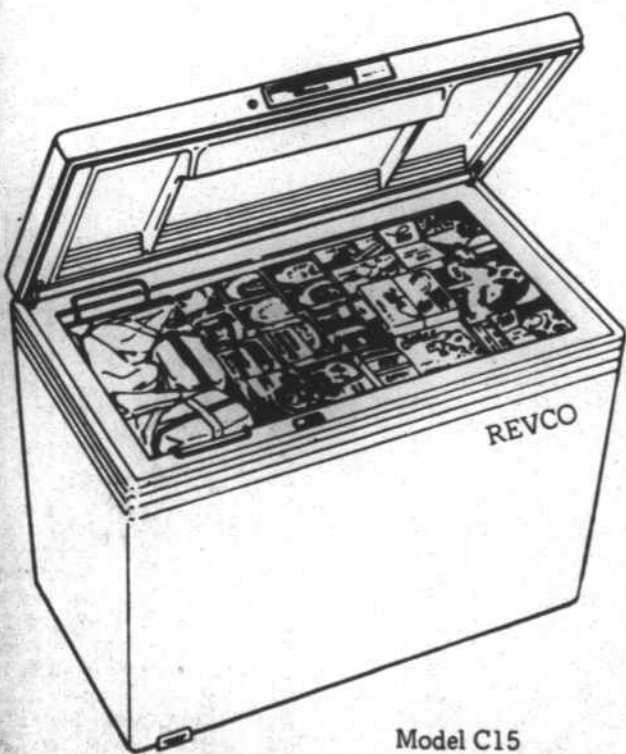
