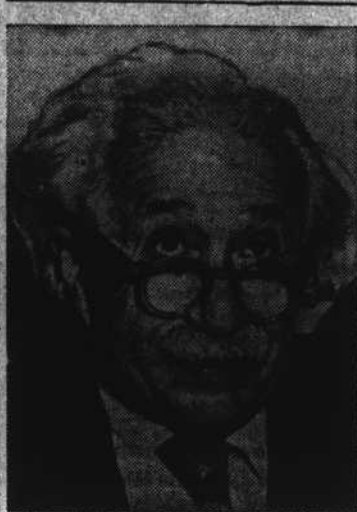

With the coming of spring weather and the swelling of dogwood buds it is time to talk about sweet corn again. There are a few gardeners who still plant early varieties of field corn for roasting ears because the ears are large and there are not many earworms. However, once they have given real sweet corn a fair trial, they will not be satisfied with field corn. There is no comparison in edible quality.

There are a number of very good hybrid corn varieties to choose from. In order of earliness the following are recommended: North Star, Seneca Chief, Hoosier Gold, Golden Cross Bantam, Iona, Huron, Aristogold. These are all yellow corns. Early and late varieties may be planted at the same time in order to get a succession of harvest, or any one variety may be planted at two weeks intervals. Corn is mostly wind pollinated and therefore it is best to plant in blocks or two or three rows rather than in a single row. Sweet corn may be planted a little closer than

field corn because it usually makes a smaller stalk growth. Sweet corn is of best quality if

used as soon as harvested. If it cannot be used immediately, it should be kept on ice or in the refrigerator, otherwise it will lose a large part of its sugar content in a few hours and will taste like field corn.

The entomologists have developed a fairly good control for the earworm—a spray of DDT emulsion that is applied to the silk. Instructions on earworm control may be obtained by writing the

If you wish to transplant a dogwood tree, be sure to protect the root system and transplant before spring growth starts.
