MUNICH, GERMANY — Specialist Third Class Benjamin L. Cox, 26, son of Dalton G. Cox, Route 1, Pollockville, recently was graduated from the Seventh Army Non-Commissioned Officer Academy in Munich, Germany.

A mortar gunner in Company C of the 370th Armored Infantry Battalion, he successfully completed a five-week course in

leadership, map reading and other military subjects.

Cox, who arrived overseas in August 1954, received his basic training at Fort Jackson, S. C. He is a former student at East Carolina State Teachers College.

Sgt. Gene Noble in German-Made Movie

MUNICH, GERMANY — Army Sergeant First Class Gene A. Noble, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. E. Noble, 905 N. East St., Kinston, recently broke into the movies

in "08/15: Third Part", a German film produced in Munich.

Sergeant Noble played the part of an American soldier during the German collapse in 1945. The film is the last part of a motion picture trilogy outlining the rise and fall of the "Wehrmacht".

The Prussian military spirit is symbolized by 08/15, originally the name of a machine gun, but now the symbol of all that was bad in the last German army.

The sergeant, regularly assigned as a tank commander in Tank Company of the 5th Infantry Division's 2nd Regiment,

entered the Army in 1946. He wears the World War II Victory Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

Noble, whose wife, Rose, is with him in Germany, attended Grainger High School.

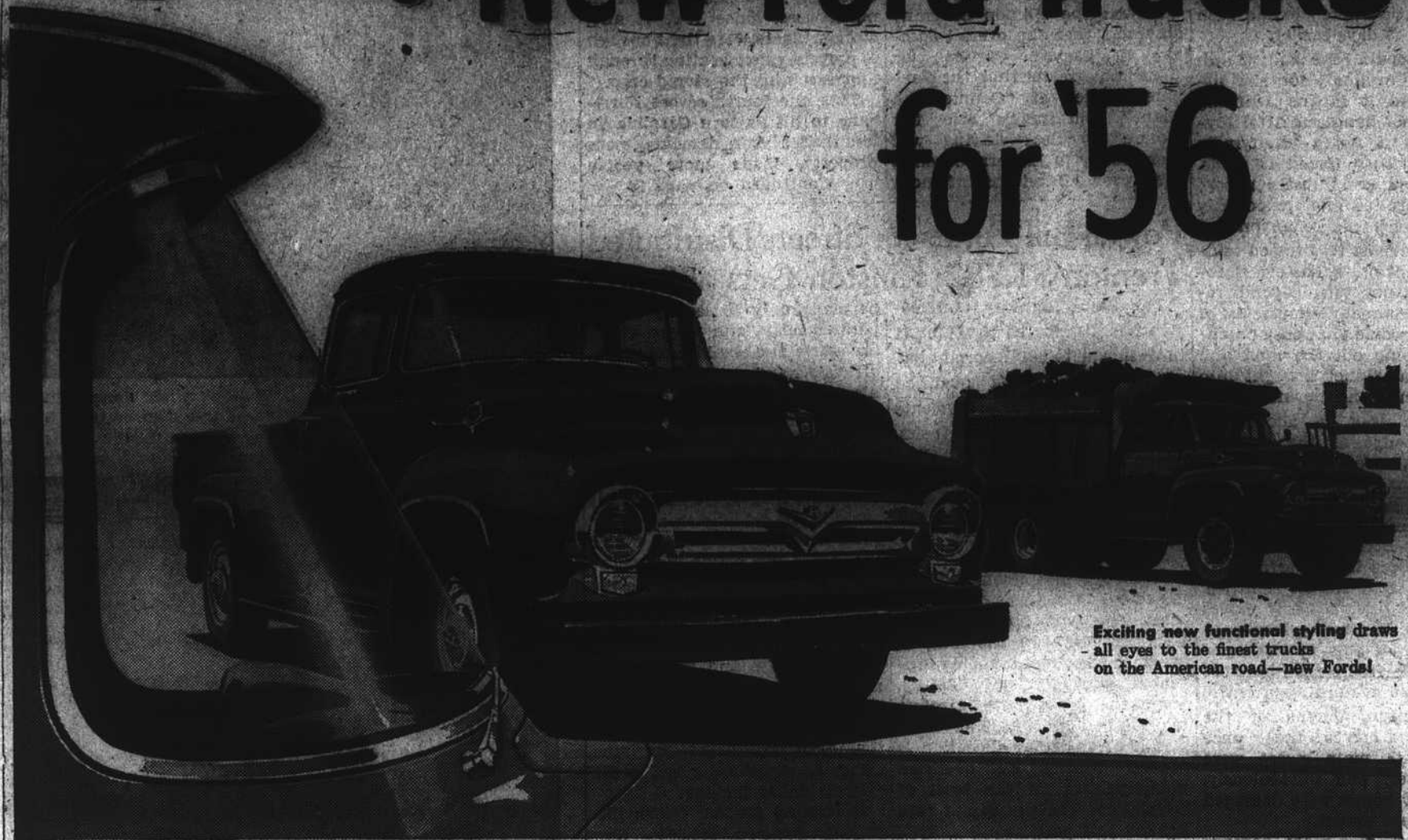

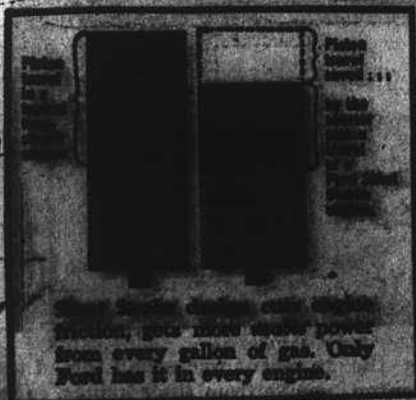
