Capture Fresh Peach Flavor In Jam



Capture some of that fresh peach goodness now and store it away for a later day. You'll be glad you did when on winter mornings your family beams over your peach jam on hot biscuits.

This recipe uses the short-boil method with liquid fruit pectin, which not only is the easiest way to make good jam, but it preserves the fine, ripe flavor of the fruit.

A cups prepared fruit (about 7½ cups (3½ lbs.) sugar 3 lbs. ripe peaches) ½ bottle liquid fruit pectin ½ cup lemon juice (2 lemons) pectin Pirst, prepare the fruit. Peel and pit about 3 pounds fully ripe peaches. Grind or chop very fine. Measure 4 cups into a very large saucepan. Squeeze the juice from 2 medium-sized lemons. Measure ½ cup juice into saucepan with peaches.

Then make the jam. Add sugar to fruit in saucepan and mix well. Place over high heat, bring to a full rolling boil, and boil hard I minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and at once stir in liquid fruit pectin. Skim off foam with metal spoon. Then stir and skim by turns for 5 minutes to cool slightly, to prevent floating fruit. Ladle quickly into glasses. Cover jam at once with ½ inch hot paraffin. Note: This jam may set slowly—allow about 2 weeks.




