

Yet, Guy Parsons, dairy speialist for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service, says that there re still some dairymen who grind up all sorts of poor roughages, mix them into the concentrate, add a ittle molasses, and think they ot a good concentrate. A few airymen even use corn cobs, straw, corn stalks and good, bad or indifferent hay in this manner. What does this grinding and mixing do for the roughage? For one thing, it forces the cow to eat poor feed against her better judgment. She can't pick the grain out of the mixture. But, regardless, it's still just poor roughage; grinding does not improve it one iota, according to Parsons.

The dairy specialist says he doubts that the average dairyman can afford to force his cows to eat this kind of feed?
