LEGAL NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 143-215, General Statutes of North Carolina, that public hearing concerning pollution of the waters of the Neuse River Drainage Basin and the assignment of classifications to said waters will be held in the Courtroom, 2nd Floor, City Hall, New Bern, North Carolina, beginning at 9:30 A. M., EST., Friday, June 26, 1959.

The waters to be considered for classification during this hearing include that portion of the Neuse River from the Wayne-Lenoir County Line to its mouth in Pamlico Sound, Nahunta Swamp from the Wayne-Greene County Line to its mouth in Contentnea Creek, Contentnea Creek from the Wilson-Greene County Line to its mouth in Neuse River, Toisnot Swamp from the Wilson-Greene County Line to its mouth in Contentnea Creek, Pamlico and Core Sounds, and that portion of the Atlantic Ocean contiguous to the Outer Banks between the Tar-Pamlico River and White Oak River Drainage Basins, and all their tributaries comprising the Neuse River Drainage Basin from the aforementioned county lines to the Atlantic Ocean. These waters border on or flow through the counties of Beaufort, Carteret, Craven, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, Pamlico, and Pitt.

All persons interested in the classification of the waters in the area designated are invited to attend and take part in the discussion. Persons desiring to be heard should give notice thereof in writing to the Committee on or before the date of the hearing. It is requested that, insofar as possible, any person desirous of offering lengthy comments and discussion in regard to the proposed classification of the streams be prepared at the public hearing to offer a written statement to be included in the record of proceedings.

Additional information and copies of the proposed classifications are available in the office of the Division of Water Pollution Control, State Board of Health, Raleigh, and may be obtained upon request.

FARM QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION: What are the advantages of cultivating cotton shallow?

ANSWER: The advantages are (1) less pruning of roots, permitting full plant growth; (2) less loss of soil moisture; (3) cultivation equipment can be operated at higher speed; (4) less power required; (5) less grass and weed seed plowed into germinating area; and (6) increased yield.
