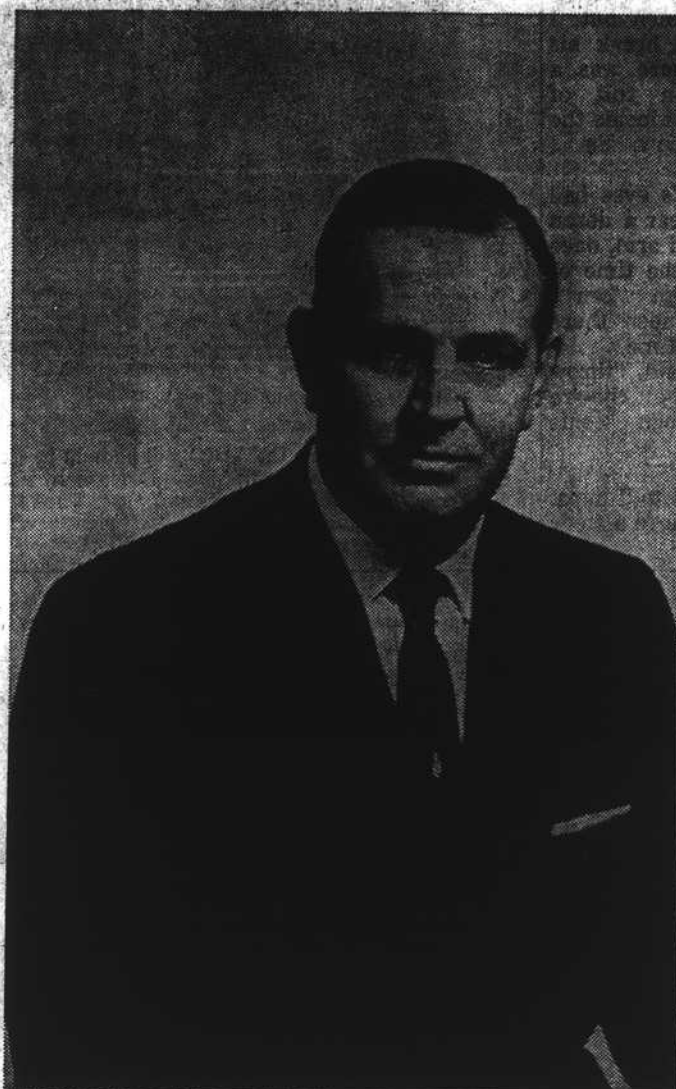


# How Do You Measure a Congressman? By His Voting Record!

## Walter Jones Stands On His Independent Voting Record

### LOOK AT HIS RECORD

- Voted Against—President's bill to increase withholding taxes, and to restore excise taxes on automobiles and telephones.
- Voted For—Supplemental appropriation for Armed Services in Viet Nam and other foreign countries.
- Voted For—Cotton Growers bill to establish, financially aid, and carry out programs of research and promotion.
- Voted Against—Act providing additional Federal Judges.
- Voted For—Bill to improve the mailing privileges of U. S. Armed Services overseas.
- Voted Against—Bill to provide luxurious mansion for the Vice President of the United States.
- Voted For—Bill to extend the time for elderly citizens to qualify for medical insurance benefits.
- Voted For—Agriculture Appropriation bill with amendment to prohibit sales to Nations doing business with North Viet Nam as long as it is under Communistic regime.
- Voted Against—Amending the Fair Employment Act.
- Voted Against—Rent Subsidy Act.
- Voted For—Bill to insure adequacy of the National Railroad Freight Car supply.
- Voted Against—Bill to include farmers under the Minimum Wage Bill.
- Voted For—Bill to permit small merchants and independent businessmen to create pensions and other benefits with tax deductible audits.
- Voted Against—Bill to increase the National Debt Ceiling.
- Voted For—"Food for Freedom" Bill—use food surplus for underprivileged Nations.
- Voted Against—Bail Reform Act of 1966—liberalize the release of accused without bond.
- Voted For—Allied Health Professions Training Act—designed to increase the number of student loans.
- Voted For—Bill to equalize the right to increase the size and weight of parcel post packages.
- Voted Against—President's Recommendation on Foreign Aid Appropriation—providing for a \$13.8 billion for foreign countries.
- Voted For—3.2% pay increase for Armed Services personnel and 3.9% for Government employees.
- Voted Against—Reclamation Act, which would remove soil conservation and water shed appropriations, etc., from the Committee on Agriculture to Committee on interior.
- Voted For—Bill to improve health benefits for retired members and members of the uniformed services and their dependents.
- Voted Against—Civil Rights Bill of 1966 — Congressman Jones stated, along with many others, that the provisions of this bill are in direct conflict with the United States Constitution.
- Voted For—Bill to authorize highway construction in 1968 and 1969.
