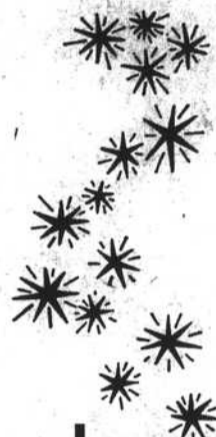
Zinnia, F1 hybrid giant cactus-flowered, "Yellow Zenith".
