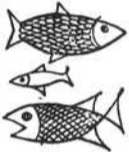

Neat Trick With Fish

Fish Rolls Surprise

1 pound fillet of sole, cut in 3 pieces; 1 package seasoned coating mix for fish; 6 cleaned raw medium shrimp; 1/2-inch cubes Cheddar cheese; stuffed olives.

Split each piece of fillet vertically to form 2 long strips. Coat with seasoned coating mix as directed on package. Roll each strip around a shrimp. Place rolls, seam side down, on greased baking sheet. Bake at 400° for about 20 minutes or until done. Arrange cheese and olives on skewers; then spear each fish roll with a skewer. Makes 3 or 4 servings.
