HELP PREVENT FOREST FIRES IN THE SOUTH



Here's a riddle for you. What do shoelaces, picture hooks and transparent tape have in common? The answer—you often can't find them when you need them most.

Some suggestions for solving the "where-is-it?" problem: Put your empty shoeboxes to work for you as separate storehouses. For example you can use one shoebox for shoe care items, another for picture-hanging necessities, others for carpet and clothes-care needs. Assign several shoeboxes for your housecleaning gear.

Start your cleaning shoebox with two cloth helpers. For example, a nylon scouring and dishcloth is non-scratching, easy on the hands, cleans and scours burned food stains, bathtub rings and whatever needs a little extra rub. A soft flexible sponge cloth has a waffle side to hold water and a grid side for removing dirt from hard-to-clean surfaces.

To do their best job for you these cloths should be kept clean and sweet-smelling. Treat them to frequent baths in a pine oil cleaner-disinfectant to clean, disinfect and deodorize all at once. Incidentally, every cleaning care kit should include a bottle or can of a high-concentration pine oil product—good for most household cleaning jobs from ashtrays to venetian blinds.

To get you started with some other shoebox storehouses, here are a few ideas for stocking your shoe care kit. It should contain such items as polishes and protectors, a sponge, brush, soft cloth and extra shoelaces.

If you've ever had a shoelace break at schoolbus time, you'll know what a valuable addition extra laces will be. Be an organization woman by organizing shoeboxes to the rescue.
