Actually, astronomers do not listen to the static, but record the intensity of radio, rediation on charts. With the construction of large radio tele-scopes in the 30s, it became possible to map large areas of the heavens from the unseen "radio stars" that emit these signals. Interestingly, the strongest signals came from the center of the Milky Way. What causes these noises? It has been determined that the origin of this radiation is the interaction between gas clouds of colliding galaxies over 200 million light-years away. These gas clouds and those in our own universe contain neutral atomic hydrogen—the most common element in interstellar space. Before the days of radio astronomy there was no way to detect or study it. Now, through our radio data, we can learn how much of it there is in our galactic system.
