Continued from page 1— even to hold a job that someone has found and foisted upon them.

Yet the children of this shiftless, sorry family need food and clothing and shelter and medical care and education as much as the children of the first mentioned family.

Viewed as one who spent two terms as a county welfare board member, this writer believes that Nixon's plan is a good one but it needs to go just one step further and that further step is to provide an easier method of removing children from totally unfit families where even the broadest public welfare program actually does the child little good, and in instances which such totally unfit parents are found a legal system for sterilization of such parents — father and mother — should be implemented to cut off the flood of unwanted, uncared for children.

Opposition to this suggestion stems from church people, racial leaders and from some sectors of the academic society; but with the world confronted by the ultimate necessity of some kind of state-enforced birth control it would be a logical and moral step to begin first with the proven unfit parents before such controls are extended to good parents.

Any program aimed at solving the poverty problem that does not include a workable birth control plan has very little chance of success.

A 1968 graduate of South Lenoir High School, Cadet Heath was appointed to the academy by Representative L. H. Fountain.

**WHAT IS THE ANSWER?**

**Q:** Dr. Garrett, I know this may sound stupid, but just what is a person's IQ?

**A:** That is not stupid at all. There are many people who talk of IQ without actually understanding what it means. Actually, the two letters represent the words "Intelligence Quotient." The letters, generally, are associated with the Stanford-Binet tests devised by Dr. L. M. Terman many years ago. Dr. Terman sought to determine a person's potential rather than his knowledge. Technically, the tests disclose the ratio of a person's mental age to his chronological age. The IQ, then, seeks to measure a person's potential, not his knowledge.
