HOME ECHOES

? — Is there a simple way to clean the side of a coffee pot? Run your automatic coffeemaker through a perking or other brewing cycle occasionally when you have put water and baking soda in the pot. Clean it thoroughly afterward with clean water, to be sure no trace of the taste of soda remains in the pot. Fill it with cold water between brewings if you use your automatic coffeemaker every day. Water absorbs unwanted odors and flavors that may develop in the appliance if stored dry.

? — Can I substitute general purpose flour for cake flour in a recipe? It can be done but remember each recipe was developed for specific results. One cup general purpose flour minus 2 tablespoons is equivalent to one cup cake flour.

? — How much fat should I allow for scrambling eggs? Heat 1/2 tablespoon fat for each egg.

? — When should the needle in a sewing machine be changed? You should follow the manufacturer's directions about the size of needle and thread to use when sewing with different fabrics. It's worth the seconds it takes to change needles for the improved sewing results, worth a trip to the store to buy the right thread for the same reason.
