Kinston Board Kills Poole Project Votes Increase in Utilities

At its mid-monthly meeting Monday night the Kinston City Council for the second time vetoed an effort by Roy Poole to build an apartment complex on a 24-acre tract of land between Northwest School and Hardee Road and approved a four per cent raise in residential and industrial power rates. Poole first had asked a building permit for the apartments in an RA-8 zone, but was turned down, and then asked that the area be rezoned from RA-8 to RA-6, in which multi-dwelling units are permissible. The council in voting the electricity rate increase agreed to eliminate the increase if the state utilities commission refuses to grant a rate increase to Carolina Power and Light Company. It has been the policy of the city for some years now to keep its rates in line with those of CP&L.
