

PAUL MUNI HAS 10TH SCREEN HIT IN PASTEUR FILM

Palace Theatre Friday, March 13th.

Paul Muni, acknowledged to be the greatest portrayer of character roles on screen or stage, has been in motion pictures just seven years, during which he has created a new record.

Every picture he has made has been a hit, each has been outstanding and his tenth film, the Cosmopolitan production "The Story of Louis Pasteur," which opens at the Palace Theatre on Friday as a First National release, is declared to be his first and most dramatic work to date.

Muni never plays two characters that are similar. His first two films were "Valiant" and "Seven Faces," which he made in 1928. Then he returned to the stage until 1932 when two of his greatest pictures were produced. These were "Scarface" and "I am a Fugitive From a Chain Gang." The following year came "The World Changes," in 1934 he made "Hi Nellie" and in 1935 he again delighted all movie fans with "Black Fury" and "Bordertown."

These two great pictures were followed by another of an entirely different type "Dr. Socrates," and now Muni is starring in his tenth picture the first biographical drama of the screen "The Story of Louis Pasteur," which is based on the life of the famous French scientist.

The rate of interest is low, being only five per cent at present. Money required can be made available at the time it is needed and interest is charged only for the period funds are actually used. Inspection costs are reasonable. Prompt service may be had on all applications and farmers desiring credit are requested to call on the Association's local representative immediately.

For the convenience of borrowers in Person county, Mr. C. C. Wilkerson, has been located in the court house at Roxboro, where he can be seen each week day during business hours. He will be glad to explain the method of operation of the Production Credit Association and to render any other service possible.

The Golden Queen variety of tomato is making Henderson County famous for its fine juice, says the county agent.

The production credit association of Davie County will be of tremendous value to farmers this season, according to the present outlook.

Thirty Yancey County farmers have placed a cooperative order for lespedeza, red clover, orchard grass, timothy and tobacco seed.

SEED LOANS ARE AVAILABLE FOR NEEDY THIS YEAR

Amount of Money Available for This Year is Less Than Last Year.

Mr. C. H. Easton, Field Supervisor, who has just returned from Columbia, S. C., where he was called to attend a meeting to discuss the loans for this year advises that he hopes to begin taking applications within the next two weeks. Just as soon as a definite date can be set he will notify the farmers through

this paper.

The amount of money available this year is much less than it has been in the past and this will mean that the loans will be smaller. No one man can apply for more than \$200.00 and the tenants of any one landlord will not be loaned an amount in excess of \$500.00. Before and application can be taken from a man he must first show that he has not received any aid from the Resettlement Administration since December 31, 1935, and must have a certificate from the agent in charge of the Resettlement Administration stating that he has not received any help from him.
