FILM LANDMARK IS BURNED DOWN FOR CIRCUS MOVIE

"Bengal Tiger" Playing at Palace Theatre Saturday A. M. 10:30 Saturday P. M. 11:30.

An historic landmark of the motion picture industry was burned to the ground. It was a barn built thirty years ago when what is now the Warner Bros. lot was a pig farm. The building, which in its time was used in several hundred pictures, was destroyed as part of a conflagration representing the burning of a circus' winter quarters, for "Bengal Tiger," which comes to the Palace theatre on Saturday of this week.

Originally used by Jesse Lasky when he first went to California to make pictures, the barn became part of many Westerns. Acquired as part of a property purchased by First National Studios, the picturesque structure continued to be used by Warner Bros. after affiliation of the two concerns.

Oakley Scored Technical Knockout Over Howard at End of Fifth Round. Sprained Ankle Prevented Howard From Returning to Fight.

Clyde "Jack" Oakley, 154 pounds, and hailing from Roxboro, N. C., defeated "Wild" Bill Howard, 152 pounds, and also hailing from the same city, last Saturday night in a scheduled ten round prize fight.

Both boys tore into each other with all they had and for several rounds it looked as tho the fight would be a matter of give and take. "Wild" Bill took a count of nine at one stage of the game, but came up laughing. It was apparent that he had only been resting. At the end of the fifth round Howard had sprained his ankle and it was deemed unwise for him to return to the fight.

In the semi-final Basil Young was awarded a technical K. O. over Gaither Dixon. Joe King and Matt Long were awarded a draw in a six round fight. Bill Winstead and Frank Holt fought to a draw for four rounds in the opening attraction.

Five hundred people crowded the Winstead Warehouse in order to see these fights. This was the largest crowd to see a boxing program in Roxboro for the past twelve months.

LEAF FREE FROM NICOTINE IS MADE

German tobacco dealers state that there is practically no nicotine-free tobacco left from the 1934 crop, and that the 1935 crop now undergoing fermentation will not be available until late in 1936. Prices obtained for nicotine-free tobacco averaged between RM 1.00 and RM 1.20 per German pound. The German pound equals 1.1 American pounds.

Washington — The U. S. Government's revenues from tobacco and kindred taxes during the month of June were more than 6,000,000 higher than in June last year, according to figures released today by the Bureau of Internal Revenue.
