The political leadership of Germany believes that it is absolutely necessary to build within the people a strong sense of self-respect. They desire to abandon the philosophy of defeat. This trong urge permeates the thinking regarding colonies, world relations and internal life. These ideas are being strongly implanted in the youth of the nation through their many study groups.




