Negro School Head Resigns After 9 Years

After nine years of service, G. W. Thomas, negro school principal, is resigning from Lee Jeffers school faculty.

In a letter to the Parents and Teachers association, he expressed appreciation for past cooperation and urged its continuance. A successor has not been named. His open letter to parents follows:

"The school year of 1939-1940 is fast approaching. I urge all parents of the Lee Jeffers School to arrange to have all students present the day the school opens. The fall term will begin on the 5th of September. Let all plan for a successful school year.

"For a period of nine years I have served as your principal, permit me to thank you for the splendid co-operation you have given me during these nine years. I regret to say, I don't think it would be advisable nor expedient for me to serve longer. I hereby offer my resignation, with a sincere hope that progress, peace, and happiness may forever abide in your school and community. Sincerely yours, G. W. Thomas."

TOBACCO SALES FOUND ACCURATE

Raleigh — Tobacco sales of North Carolina warehousemen are now in almost perfect condition.

That is the finding of C. D. Baucum, chief of the State Department of Agriculture's weights and measures division, whose staff has just completed a check of all tobacco sales in the Border belt.

"Typical of the findings of inspectors is the case of warehouses in one large market where 4,387,356 pounds of leaf were sold through the week ending August 11, representing approximately 53,000 baskets with a total error in weight of only 86 pounds above the tolerance being found," Baucum said. "This condition re-

flects credit to the warehouse operators and gives the farmers assurance that they are getting paid pound-for-pound for the tobacco they sell. Then too, the warehousemen seem to appreciate the effort of the Department to aid them in securing accurate weighing equipment."

Baucum explained that for the first time in the history of the state, public weighers—including warehousemen and ginners—are being licensed under the North Carolina Weighmasters Act enacted by the 1939 General Assembly. Under the provisions of the act, weighers are required to certify all commodities they weigh as to correctness of weight.

Meanwhile, the weights and measures chief said that tobacco scales in the New Bright tobacco belt are now being checked.

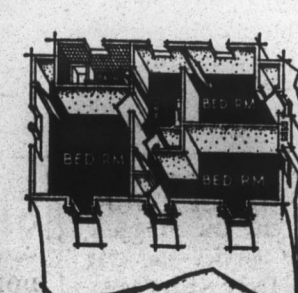
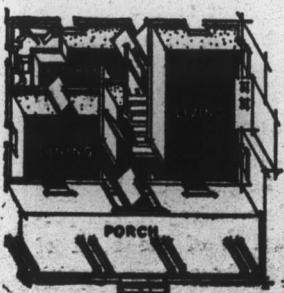
