

### Farm Plans For Year Must Be Signed Shortly

The Raleigh and Washington Agricultural offices request that all "Farm Plans" for 1940 be signed by April 15, 1940, according to announcement made recently by H. K. Sanders, Person county farm agent.

The "Farm Plan" is exactly what its name implies, said Mr. Sanders, who added, it is each farmer's own plan of what he intends to do in 1940. The signing of the plan does not place any one under any obligation. If anyone signs to make changes in the crops to be planted or the practices to be carried out, it is all right to do so.

The "Farm Plan" gives each farmer, a concise statement of his allotted acres, both his tobacco allotment and his allotment of other crops, such as corn, wheat, oats, barley, sorghums, millet, Sudan grass, etc.

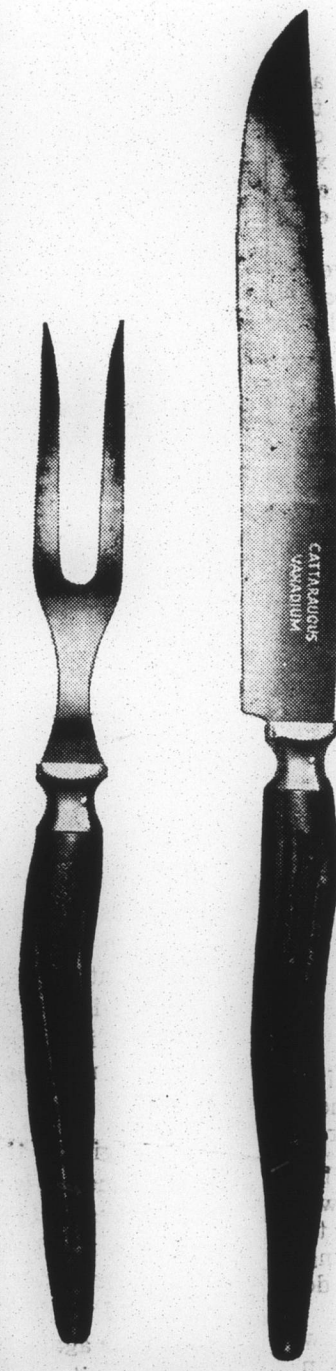

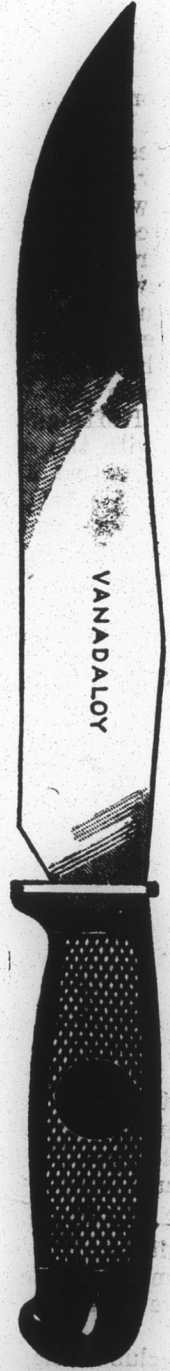

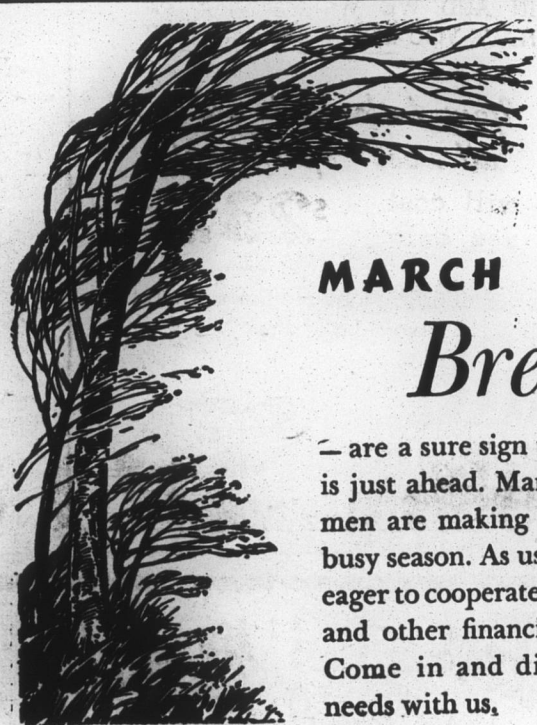
