STAGE SET FOR START IN RATION PROGRAM

(continued from front page) Raleigh Meeting. Emphasized by Cole was proper care of Ration Book II, and the application of commonsense in its use. Many merchants present seemed to be disappointed that Point Values of foods to be rationed were not revealed to them in advance, but Woods and other officials explained that this information will be taken on Mar. 1 and will not be released until after the beginning of the

"Freeze" period, which started last night and will continue through next Sunday.

Woods, in an effort to clarify limitations read a list of processed foods and others expected to be on the ration basis. It was also suggested by him that inventories be taken on March 1 and 31 and that stocks in stores be arranged in ration sections and plainly marked for point values.

He also said that all retailers must secure copies of the "Official Table of Point Values on Processed Foods". These tables are available at Post Offices. At least one of these tables must be prominently displayed or posted in every retail store. The merchants may use only this chart or table to govern the point values of the processed food they sell.

To replenish stocks it was said that points retailers receive from customers for sale or processed foods, may be used to replenish stocks, (just as sugar and coffee stamps have been used). Merchants are to paste these coupons on gummed coupon sheets. (Form OPA R-120) which the Rationing Board will furnish. Put on the same sheet stamps having the same point value, and good during same validity periods.

CONSUMER DECLARATION

Processed Foods and Coffee

I HEREBY CERTIFY that I am authorized to apply for and receive a War Ration Book Two for each person listed below who is a member of my family unit, or the other person or persons for whom I am acting whose War Ration Book One I have submitted to the Board;

That the name of each person and number of his or her War Ration Book One are accurately listed below;

That none of these persons is confined or resident in an institution, or is a member of the Armed Forces receiving subsistence in kind or eating in separate messes under an officer's command;

That no other application for War Ration Book Two for these persons has been made;

That the following inventory statements are true and include all indicated foods owned by all persons included in this Declaration:

Coffee

1. Pounds of coffee owned on November 23, 1942, minus 1 pound for each person included in this Declaration whose age as stated on War Ration Book One is 14 years or older.

2. Number of persons included in this Declaration whose age as stated on War Ration Book One is 14 years or older.

Canned Foods

Include all commercially canned fruits (including spiced); canned vegetables; canned fruit and vegetable juices; canned soups, chili sauce, and catsup.

Do not include canned olives; canned meat and fish; pickles, relish; jellies, jams, and preserves; spaghetti, macaroni, and noodles; or home-canned foods.

3. Number of cans, bottles, and jars (8-ounce size or larger) of commercially packed fruits, vegetables, juices and soups, chili sauce and catsup owned on February 21, 1943, minus 5 for each person included in this Declaration.
