

### KELLEY'S LIFE OF WRIGHT BROTHERS INTERESTS STATE

North Carolinians Had Share In Early History Of Aviation.

RALEIGH, May 20. — A new biography of the Wright brothers—Wilbur and Orville—just off the press, is said to be almost a history of the development of aviation. Written by Fred C. Kelley, newspaper columnist and magazine writer, the text has been approved by Orville Wright, according to the publishers.

The book goes into details about the negotiation of the Wright brothers with the United States and foreign governments

and trends to show that lack of appreciation of what heavier than air flying might mean on part of this Government led to faster development of aviation in Europe.

The book pays its respects to newspapers of 40 years ago for their lack of interest and perception because they more or less ignored the Wrights while they were working out the fundamental principles of aviation—the factors which have played such important part in the current global war.

One of the most interesting phases of this biography deals with relations between the Wrights and the Smithsonian Institution. The unfortunate trend of these relations led to the Wright brothers sending their original plane, the one that flew at Kitty Hawk, to London instead of putting it in the Smithsonian Institution at Washington.

The trouble between the Wrights and the institution has been pretty well dissipated now, and there is still some hope that soon after the war the original plane will be returned to this country.

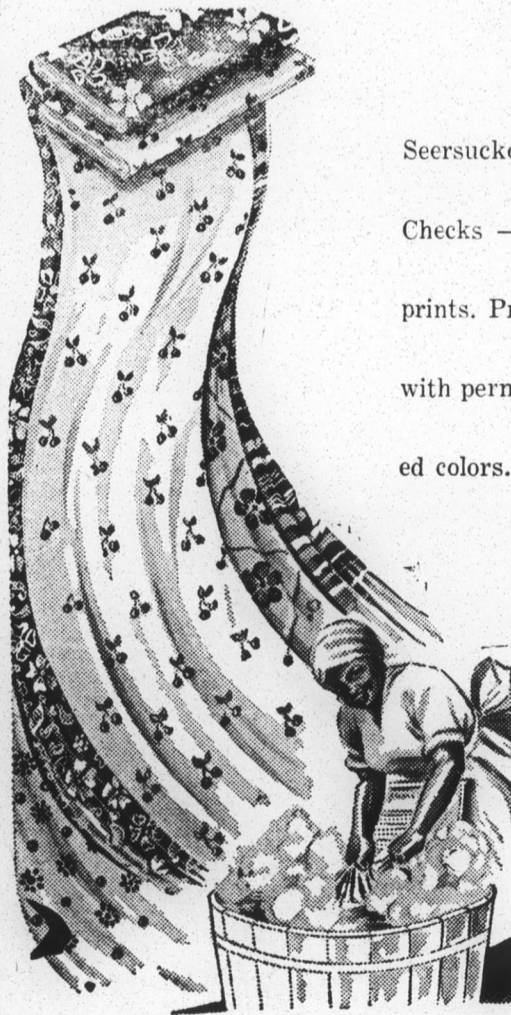
