47.7 PERCENT OF VISITS TO USES ARE WORLD WAR VETS

116,838 Visits Were Made To Local USES Offices in December, 1945

Indicative of the speed with demobilized is the fact that al- Black Mountain, N. C. most half, 47.7 percent, of the visits in which services were rendered in December in local offices of the United States Employment Service, were made by veterans, approximately 99 percent of them of World War II.

Robert M. du Bruyne, acting \$3.00. State director of the USES, reports that 116,838 visits were made to local USES offices in December, about an average month for 1945. Of these visits, additional services were rendered in 109,605 cases, and 52,326 of these cases were those of veterans, a veteran increase from a proportion of about one out of ten in the early months of last


