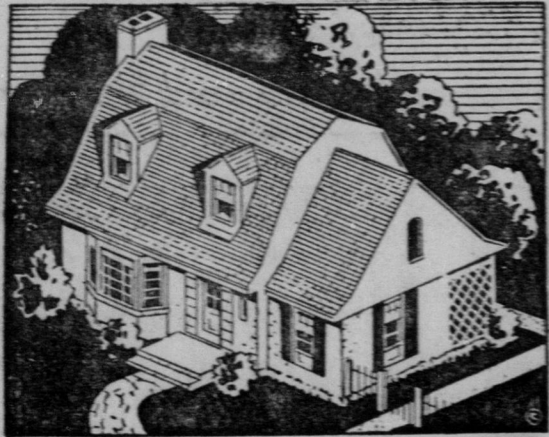

bar in 1936, but prior to that taught in Black Mountain high school for five years. After receiving his law license he became associated with Claude L. Love in the practice of law here.

Mr. Taylor entered the navy as a lieutenant, Junior grade, and later was promoted to lieutenant. He received his indoctrination training at Fort Schuyler, N. Y., and was transferred to the amphibious forces and sent to Camp Bradford, Va., for further training.

He was assigned to an LST as executive officer and sent to the Pacific, participating in the battles of Okinawa, Lingayen Gulf, and Nasugbu near Corregidor. His ship was hit by a Japanese suicide plane off Okinawa.

After he was promoted to lieutenant he served as commanding officer of an LST.

Mr. Taylor resides at Black Mountain with his wife, the former Miss Evelyn Reeves of Leicester, and their two children.

In making his announcement, Mr. Taylor said:

"It is my purpose, if elected, to represent the Democratic party and all of the people of Buncombe County without obligation to any faction, class, individual or group of individuals."

Black Mountain has not had a representative in the State Legislature since Mr. Finch held that office in 1937 and 1939.
