Mrs. Ruth Bell and family of Maryland are visiting her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Logan Rutherford.

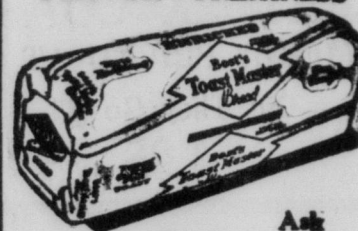
The Mills Chapel Senior choir has been reorganized and is progressing nicely. The Junior choir is planning on buying new robes.
