Sir Alfred Zimmern, distin-guished British educator and author, of London, England, will be the principal speaker at the thirty-fourth annual meeting of the Presbyterian Educational As-sociation of the South which open-ed here Wednesday night (June 23) to continue through June 29. The theme of the three addresses to be given by Doctor Zimmern is "Christian Education Confronts the World Community."
