Dr. Chen Chih-mai is the author of "Parliamentary Opinion of Dele-gated Legislation" (doctoral dissertation) Columbia University Press, 1933; "Potitical Science" (in Chinese), 21st printing, 1947; "Chinese Government and Politics," 3 vols.
