

Of the six permanent plans of G. I. Insurance, the 20-payment with World War II veterans, the Veterans Administration has an-

More than half of the 1,500,000 in force are 20-payment life policies, the VA said. Under this plan the veteran pays his regular premiums for 20 years. Second most popular permanent insurance plan is the 30-payment life. Ordinary life is third choice among veterans. The various endowment plans are least popular.

Permanent policies now amount to more than \$6,500, 000,000 worth of insurance, VA explained. However, nearly 5,000,000 World War II veterans have not yet converted their temporary insurance to permanent forms of G. I. Insurance.

More than a million and a half veterans were in training under the provisions of the G. I. Bill on September 1, 1948, the Veterans Administration reported.

Over half - 871,000 - were studying in schools and colleges, with 267,000 enrolled for institutional on-farm training and 414,000 taking training on the job.
