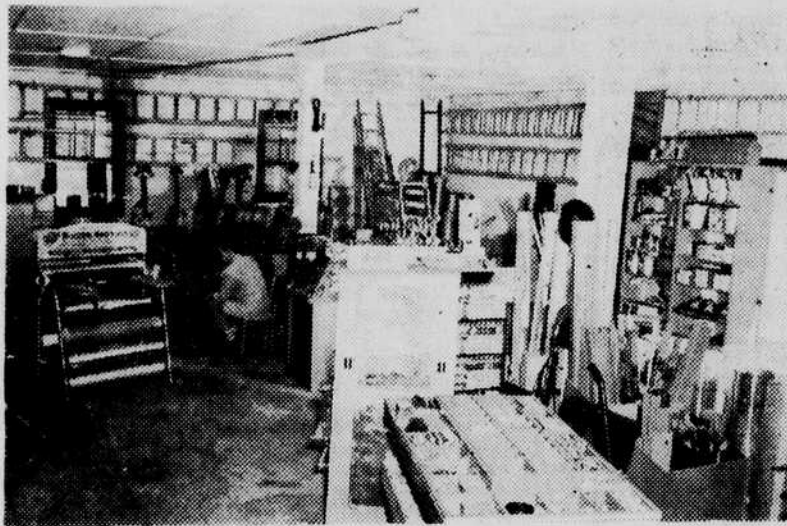

COLONY era in the late 16th Century at Roanoke Island, N. C., was made from conch shells which had washed ashore on the ocean beach.

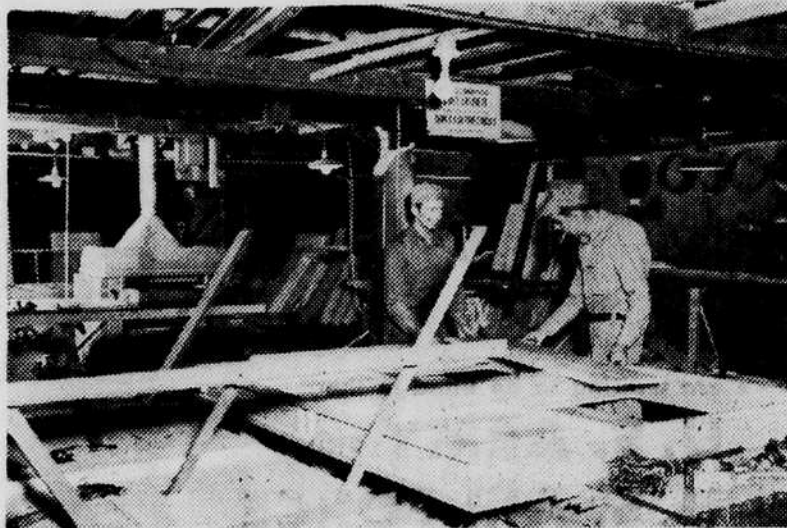
