We left Chipmunk Lodge Nov. 4 in a pouring rain which lasted day and night till we reached here at noon the 16th and through at night. The Hammond organ in the trailer which we pulled, came through without any damage whatsoever and is affording the usual pleasure.

We found our place in excellent shape, inside and out, and the citrus trees loaded so that several branches are sweeping the ground. The fruit is much better than any we have had in previous years, showing the results of the attention we have given them. Hibiscus, flame-vine, buginilla and other shrubs in bloom, have climbed in these two years over the 7 ft. trellis which we erected — tongue-in-cheek — last year for the 2½ - 3 ft. shrubs at that time. Now they are on top of the roof and we're forced to figure out some remedy to give as much as possible of the beautiful shrubs (as well as the roof of the house).

We didn't like too much to leave Chipmunk Lodge, but didn't mind a bit missing the 11 degrees temperature reported from Asheville a few days ago. It was summer here yesterday (83 degrees) and is starting to be the same today and the sun is grand. We have had 35 degrees a couple nights since we came (no damage). Last night it was 61 degrees.

Our best to the "Black Mountain News." Keep it coming. While we like to wear short-sleeve, open-neck shirts, and to eat to our heart's content luscious grapefruit, our hearts are in "Them Tar Hills" fer sure.
