 American foods but there was one in particular the name of which he could not recall.
 "It was yellow and sometimes it was white," he explained. "Sometimes it was big and sometimes it was small. But it was always good," and he smacked his lips as his thoughts rushed back across the Atlantic and half a continent to Indiana where he

viewed he'd eaten this delicacy which he could not forget, even though he didn't recall the name.
 Finally in desperation he picked up a paper and made a roll. While he watched he stuck it up to his mouth and pretended to be eating, turning the paper in his hands to show that it was round.
 "It was something like this," he said, "I believe you called it something like maize on a stick."
 That was the clue. Of course if we hadn't been so dense we'd have known long before that he meant corn on the cob.

 was carried by a Mr. Pitman, and it took him a good part of the day to get in to Swannanoa with the mail for the afternoon trains which ran about 2 o'clock.
 "The office hours were practically from sunup to sundown, and folks came all day long for mail, etc.

"One of the most interesting patrons of this office was a man by name of W. Jobe Cleveland, who came here and lived in a one-room cabin just west of Swannanoa. He had a great deal of registered mail, mostly addressed to places in Cleveland, Ohio. To register this mail made me very nervous, as I was scared of the government. This man had a little window in his cabin, and no one was allowed to enter therein. His mail and his outside necessary things were carried on by a colored slave, Uncle Joe Davidson, who died a few years ago at 105.

"Uncle Joe brought Mr. Cleveland's mail and I gave him registered receipts, always with fear and trembling. Mr. Cleveland was so queer that I did not know what might happen if I made a mistake.

This man was a patron of this office until several years ago when he passed on. No one ever knew from whence he came, or why this life of seclusion. He must have been about 60 years of age at this time, and I have seen him poke his head out his cabin window. He had a long black beard and was an intelligent looking person, but his mail to me was a nightmare.

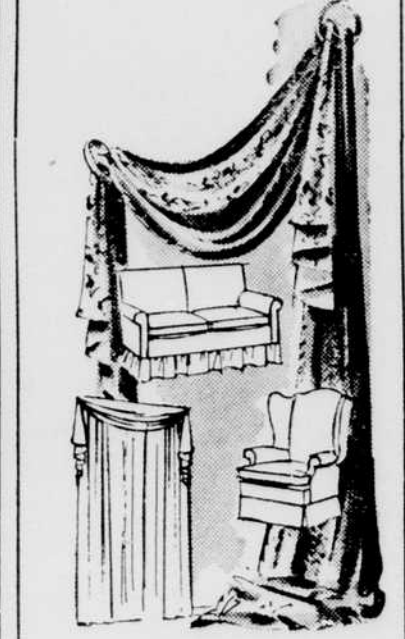
DOUGHERTY, WOODWARD HAVE CIRCLE PROGRAM

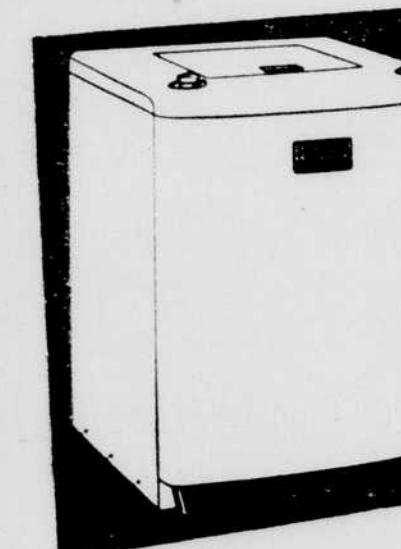
