At the fourth and closing session of the study Miss Louise Simmons reviewed a book of poetry written in English by a young Indian Christian, Chandran Devanesen, with a sketch of the poet's life, some interesting comments about the unusual illustrations in which Christianity is interpreted in Indian symbols, and read selected parts of the poetry itself.

Much color was added to the study by the loan of articles made

in India by members of the group. Mrs. MacKenzie brought Indian clothing on one evening and dressed models to illustrate how the clothing was worn. Eddie and Jimmy Crumpler modeled boys' clothing complete with draped turbans. Julia A. n. Dickens showed a girl's costume, and Mrs. M. C. Dickens served as a model to illustrate how the sari is draped and worn by Indian women. Among the many interesting and beautiful articles loaned for the four evenings of study were a handmade tray intricately inlaid with tiny bits of wood and ivory to show elephants in a spring setting in a woodland scene, a papier mache bowl closely resembling cloisonne, and a cerulean silk scarf embroidered in mythical Indian designs in thread of gold. These were sent by Mrs. W. D. Weatherford from among the gifts brought her by her son, who has worked and travelled in India recently.



day with a panel discussion on "Necessity for Coordinating Rehabilitation Resources". P. L. Collins, manager of the Oteen V.A. hospital was moderator and the panelists were Dr. B. B. Bagby, Jr., chief of physical medicine and rehabilitation service at Oteen; Mrs. Grace Maxey, Oteen nursing service; Samuel E. Steele, Oteen vocational counseling service; Dr. George Wilson of Asheville, V.A. consultant in physical medicine and rehabilitation; Dr. Hamilton W. Stevens, Asheville-Buncombe county health officer; Miss Nell Mills, social worker of the Winston-Salem V.A. regional office; Charles H. Warren, director of vocational rehabilitation for North Carolina; Beach Keller of the Asheville office of the state employment security commission; and Paul Young, Beacon Mills personnel manager.

Other highlights of the opening day were addresses by Judge Sam M. Cathey of Asheville, "1954 Handicapped Man of the Year", and Dr. Donald A. Covatt, associate director of the Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation of the New York University Bellevue Medical center.

The workshop portion of the conference was divided into five sub-groups which discussed three major areas, including "Integrating Resources for Maximum Rehabilitation in the area of working relationships in the Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Service"; "Integrating resources for maximum rehabilitation in the area of hospital relationships with all related services and resources"; and "Integrating resources for maximum rehabilitation in area of community relationships."

A surprise visit was made to the workshop by the administrator of the Veterans Administration,

H. V. Higley, Admiral J. T. Boone, chief medical director of the Veterans Administration; and Dr. H. B. Cupp, area medical director, Atlanta. These officials spent some time personally greeting the conferees and visiting the different sub-groups of the workshop.

Other Veterans Administration central office personnel attending were Dr. Frederick Balsam, chief, program development, physical medicine and rehabilitation service, and Dr. John E. Davis, chief of corrective therapy.
