Born in 1860, Mrs. Todd is a remarkable person with a memory as sharp as a freshly-honed razor. She recalls many of the events of Reconstruction and insists on living alone, with her renters, in the huge structure which she and her husband built back when they made rooms as large as 5-room houses are now. She has been coming to Montreat since it first opened and one of her prized possessions is a picture of the first foreign missions conference taken in front of the community building. Mrs. Todd attended along with Mr. Todd and her mother.

Although she has threatened to stop her yearly visits, the wife of one of her grandsons says that she is hardly home at Laurens in the fall until she starts immediately making plans to return the next spring. One of her first questions was: "Who can I get to stay with me and drive my car at Montreat this summer?"

I had to admit that I didn't know but like her granddaughter-in-law I know she'll have one and will be back in Montreat at the usual time, come June.

Buzzie Brown, daughter of Mrs. Gustavo Brown of Black Mountain, has seen a dream of long standing come true.

Back in the ninth grade Buzzie won a cup for being the outstanding player in the Buncombe county ninth grade tourney. She filed away deep in her mind the

hope that some day she would be chosen on the coveted all-county team. She must have been disheartened when she took the court this year against the other teams and saw the size of some of the guards.

But the best doesn't always come in the largest packages. When the coaches, following the custom originated by the Black Mountain News a few years ago, made their selection for 1955 Buzzie was a first string guard. To which she probably adds, "all this and heaven, too."

Dale Ritchie, star center for the Warhorses, was a unanimous selection for a first string berth.

My gripe is that they left off five of my favorite girls and four boys. But just wait till next year.

Down in Eastern Carolina at Bunn the high school girls' team completed on Feb. 20 a record of 65 games without defeat. The six regulars there have played together for three years without losing.

It was back in 1952 that the school got a new gym and a new coach. The coach was Mrs. T. E. Hinnant, cousin of Woodruff Beddingfield of Black Mountain. Graduate of Eastern Carolina at Greenville, she was the former Jean Beddingfield, one of the greatest athletes ever to attend the Bunn school. She was all-county in basketball.

But she didn't confine her activities to the court. In 1947 she tucked her brown hair under her cap and went out to pitch a semi-pro baseball game. After she had struck out six men in the first three innings, the opposition began asking who this fast ball pitcher was. Although they were greatly annoyed when they discovered "he" was a girl, they didn't hesitate to demand that she be removed from the mound and the game. They were afraid she'd get hurt.

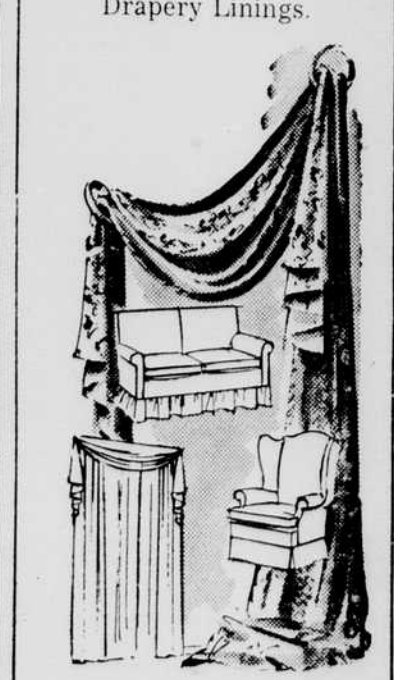

rean GI Bill must start training within three years after they leave service or forfeit all further rights to the benefits. This requirement is contained in the law itself and, therefore, was not affected by the President's proclamation.

Those who start their education or training within the required three-year period must complete their Korean GI Bill Training by January 31, 1963, or eight years after discharge, whichever is earlier. The terminating date of January 31, 1963 resulted from the President's proclamation.

For GI loans on homes, farms or businesses, eligible veterans of the Korean conflict period now have until January 31, 1965 to receive a VA guaranty or insurance as a result of the President's proclamation. No further guaranties or insurance may be issued after that date on loans made to veterans under the present law.

For vocational rehabilitation under Public Law 894, eligible dis-

abled veterans of the Korean conflict period must start in to finish their rehabilitation by January 31, 1964, or nine years after separation, whichever is earlier. These termination dates apply to all eligible veterans except those in certain "hardship" categories. For the latter, an additional year is granted but it is necessary to complete their rehabilitation.

Veterans Administration issued a checklist of certain deadline dates before which eligible veterans of the Korean conflict period must act if they wish to take advantage of certain benefits.
