

The Proposed 25 Cents Supplemental Tax For Schools

"It is the duty of the county board of education or the board of trustees of a city administrative unit to provide suitable supplies for school buildings under its jurisdiction, such as window shades, fuel, chalk, erasers, blackboards, and other necessary supplies, etc."

The Parent-Teacher council of the county knew this and realized that the county board would have to find new sources for funds when it voted some time ago to support a 25 cents supplemental tax for the county to be used for the maintenance and improvement of schools.

Elsewhere in this issue two veteran county educators tell of the rapid growth of the community, bringing about a need for more rooms, more equipment, and more supplies than are furnished by the state. In fact many districts find the funds received from state sources inadequate to meet the need for fuel, telephone, transportation, and other necessary items.

This has been true in Buncombe county for a good many years and, as a result, the county board and superintendent have had to stretch and trim the budget in order to provide even the necessities.

With a limited amount of funds available the county commissioners have given until it has hurt but even then that has not been adequate to meet the needs here for an expanding school population that greets the teachers and principals each year.

Proposed has been a supplemental tax of 25 cents which would cost a person with an evaluation of \$5,000 approximately \$12.50. This, of course, will be subject to approval by the voters at a special election if and when it is called.

The 25 cents tax would furnish funds which officials have said are needed if the schools are to continue to operate at the present standard in Buncombe county. The decision will rest with the jury, in this case the voters and parents. The outcome will depend on how much we want our children to have the very best that we are able to give.

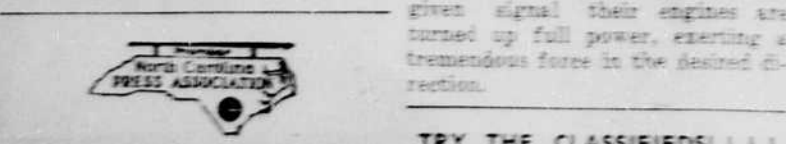
