Coach Byrd has led and coached these girls during their five years of basketball and is naturally happy to see so much of his team leave. When asked if these girls were born athletes and good enough not to need much coaching, he kind of smiled and said that although the girls were all natural athletes, it was something quite different that made them excel as a team.

"These girls," he said, "all had very strong personalities and were the most determined group I have ever come up against. They are stubborn strong-willed and would never give up in their abilities and such self-determination that to concede defeat was unrecognizable in their makeup."

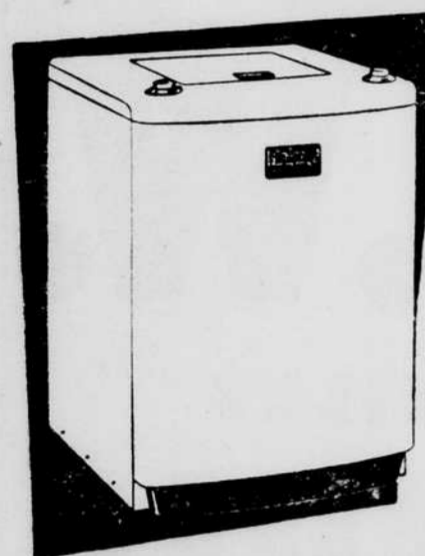

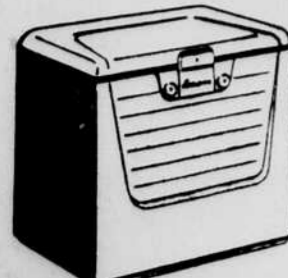

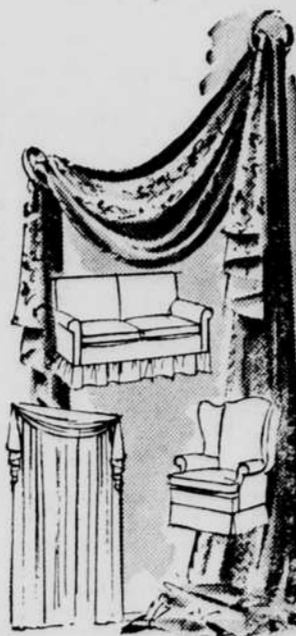

The Rev. Eugene Byrd, member of the Owen High school faculty, conducted the devotional, and Mrs. Olin Dillard of Candler, chairman of District No. 1 of the North Carolina P.T.A., was principal speaker. Mrs. Rooby Wilson, chairman of the P.T.A. State Magazine committee, spoke briefly. E. N. Howell, Swannanoa school principal, led the musical part of the program.

Graduate of Wake Forest college, the Rev. Mr. Huneycutt served as a chaplain in the South Pacific during World War II. After coming to Black Mountain he was recalled to active duty and spent a year in Europe with the U. S. Air Force. His family remained here.

In accepting the presidency, the popular Baptist minister pointed out that he was doing so with the understanding that the executive committee and all supporters of the school would pitch in and help.

Homer Olin Weeman, 70, 34 Windsor road, Asheville, was killed instantly at 2:40 Monday afternoon when struck by a car at the Woolsey Dip on Merrimon avenue. Mrs. Weeman is a member of the faculty at Owen High school.

The driver of the car and a passenger were held under bond of \$3,000 pending the results of an inquest which Dr. P.R. Terry, county coroner, called for Wednesday morning.

Red Cross headquarters in Grand Park, Mich., he was a pioneer merchant of that city and a member of the University of Michigan Alumni club. Surviving are the widow, Delight Paugh Weeman, of Grand Park, Mich.; and three other children, Stanley and Harry Weeman, both of Grosse Ile, Mich. Funeral plans are incomplete.
