1954 ACCIDENT FACTS

RALEIGH—There were 40,449 reported motor vehicle accidents in North Carolina last year, more than half of them auto collisions. Other type accidents were "striking fixed object" 1,974; "overtaken in roadway" 1,527; and "run off roadway" 7,561. Collisions of motor vehicles accounted for the most fatalities—304. Of all the accidents 880 were fatal, 10,267 were
