Surviving are the widow; three sons, Albert Jr., Frank and Ernest of the home; two sisters of New York, and one brother also of New York.

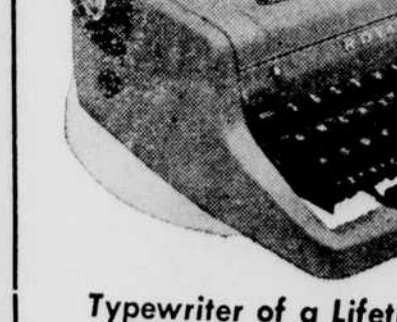
Rites Conducted For W. Nanney
