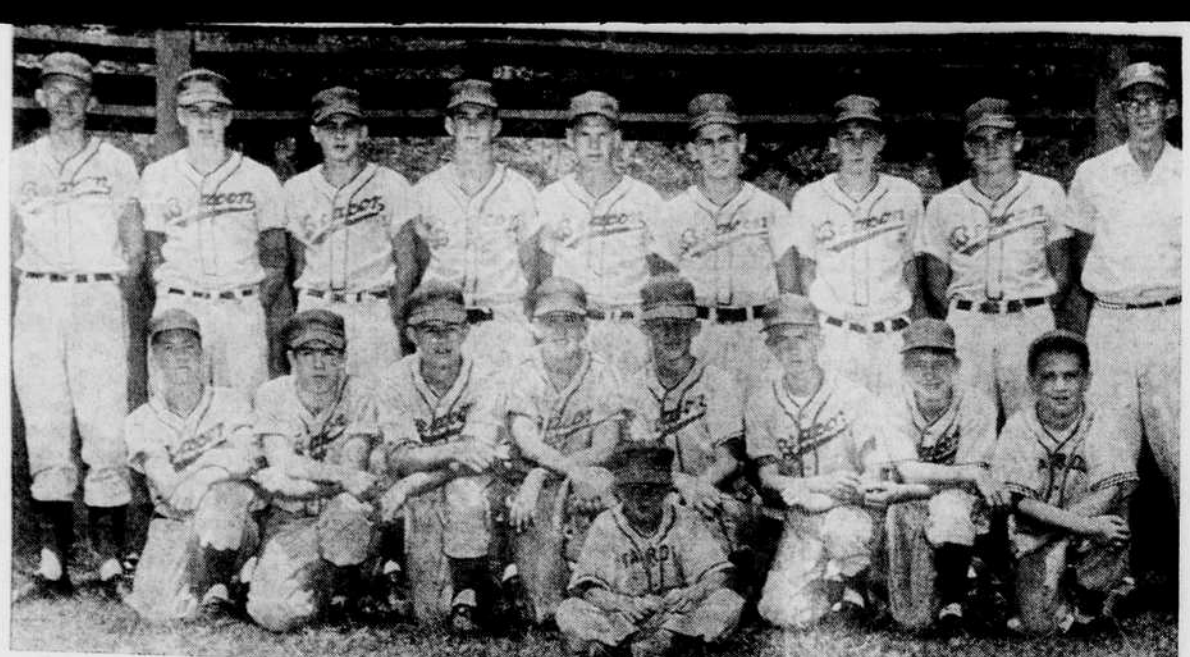

Veterans having GI loans on their homes, farms or businesses can make extra payments...

The minimum extra payment a veteran may make on his loan, VA said, is at least the amount of one month's payment...

About 1,076,000 loans have already been repaid in full since the beginning of the VA loan program in 1946.
