N. C. Shuford, principal, announced yesterday. About 10 of these were in the group which moved up to high school level this Fall from elementary schools in the two school districts which are served by this consolidated high school.

In addition to capacity classes in the 23 regular classrooms at Owen, classes are being held in cafeteria, library, gymnasium and band room. This doubling up on use of facilities was necessary to enable all groups to meet for regular studies under direction of a staff of 29 teachers. Mr. Shuford said.

Increase in the number of newcomers to the community accounts also in large part for a sharp increase this year in enrollment at the Black Mountain Elementary school. A. G. Burchfiel, new principal who assumed the post this year, reported. Thirty-five new pupils this year place its total enrollment, in grades 4 through 8, at a total of 721—with all classrooms being in use under direction of a teaching staff of 22 headed by Mr. Burchfiel. Hope was expressed that an additional teacher may be acquired in line with eligibility regulations governed by high enrollment.

At the Black Mountain Primary school, headed by Principal Leonard T. Keever, there are a number of children of newcomers to the community, but a decrease in the overall total number of pupils entering school for the first time. A marked increase in such enrollments is anticipated next year, and this trend is expected to continue upward throughout the county for the 1958-59 school year, Mr. Keever said.

A slight decrease in enrollments this year at the first grade level was also indicated at the Swannanoa Elementary school of which E. N. Howell is principal, but in the higher levels increases jumped total enrollment to 984, an increase of 20 students over last year, including a number of new residents in that area. Twenty-nine teachers and a librarian make up the staff. Hope was expressed that one new teacher may be secured to replace a loss of one member of the staff last year.

Mr. Burchfiel and his family

came here this year from Brevard

college and are now at home in Black Mountain on Laurel circle. He expressed "warm appreciation" of the fine reception given him by the community and the school in his new work.

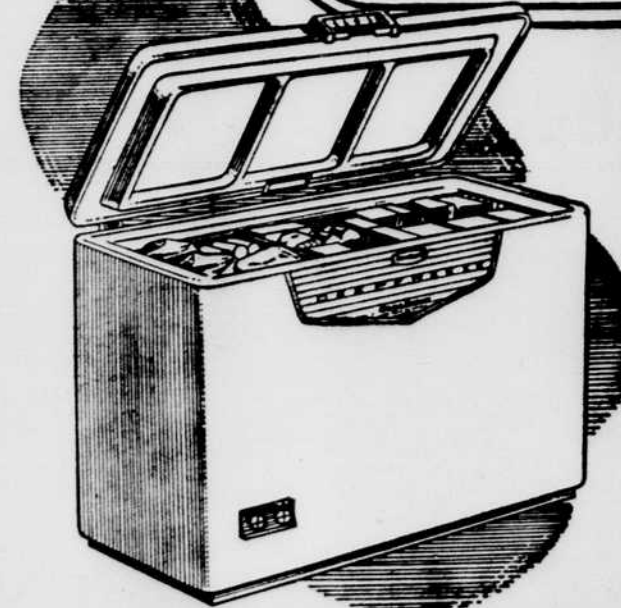
