Water Levels

RALEIGH — Although seasonal declines began in some areas, water levels in North Carolina remained above normal in June, according to the monthly water resources report issued Friday by the State Board of Water Commissioners.

The report, based on information from the U. S. Geological Survey, said scattered showers throughout the month helped keep stream flows in the western Piedmont above normal for the tenth consecutive month. Runoff at the Yadkin River index station at Wilkesboro since last October 1 is the highest on record for the period. Flows began to decline toward the end of the month.

The rainfall total of 2.22 inches recorded at Charlotte was 1.22 deficient for the month but the excess for the year is 1.61 inches.

Streams in the mountain region also were above normal for the tenth consecutive month, although they declined to near average at the end of June.

Rainfall in the mountains was 2.8 inches, well below average.
