

STABLE FAMILIES

"Today the stability of family life is threatened by forces un-dreamed of several generations ago. In the life span of one gen-eration, the world has been shaken by two world wars. There has been widespread industrialization and unthought of development in advantation transportation and comand unthought of development in education, transportation and com-munication. Also there has been a constant rise in conflicting ideologies. The stability of the family cannot escape the effect these forces have had upon total life in the modern world. "The efforts to main family unlife in the modern world. "The efforts to main family un-ity must always be present and in constant practice. One of the first things to deal with in building more stable families is to recognize that family unity HAS changed. Basically, there are certain historic characteristics that must be pre-served. Likewise, there are certain modern characteristics that must be discarded. Therefore, one may draw the conclusion that everydraw the conclusion that every-thing old is not bad; and every-thing new is not necessarily good. Thus, intelligent discrimination is necessary. The basis of such dis-crimination may be recognition that the home is not the basis of the entire society, as it once was. Today, members of the family do not depend upon each other for survival, since industrialization has shifted the means of a family's livelihood. Many varied careers attract different members from a

family. Once the purpose of a home was to unerringly instruct the daughters to be wives and the sons to follow in their fathers' "Since time immemorial, people have made themselves aware of the fact that the divine plan of God for humanity is establishment of a family.
