would alternate with six weeks of schooling throughout the year. Under such a plan, we would want to pick such students from the top echelon of their classes," he said. Mr. Ford stated that there "are today employment placements open for 2,000,000 skilled workers in the nation. The greatest portion

of the currently unemployed are those who are lacking in real skills. We need more schools with vocational training—so far as I know, the only school in this area offering such training is the Lee Edwards High school," Mr. Ford said. He added: "Ninety per cent of applications filled out at our plant in Black Mountain are made by individuals who have not completed the tenth grade of school. There is a limited number of opportunities for this type of employee. We do employ some of them, and train them, but this is a long process—in a group of six workers, for instance, only about one such worker can be absorbed. The trouble is," he declared, "young people have not appreciated what lies ahead of them when they get out of school—or what they expect to earn. Meanwhile, we are continuously searching for skilled people—and we must get across this need to all our youngsters in this area, just as we get across the need for a good labor climate, if Western North Carolina is to attract more industry." Mr. Ford stated, adding, "I am not critical of the WNC school system. What we have is good, but we need to add to it, we need to get the people interested and see that they do not just take second best." He suggested that members of the Chamber of Commerce and local students make visits to the local Ex-Cell-O plant to observe industry in action.

William Hickey presided at the meeting. H. McGuire Wood reported that Chamber of Commerce maps of the town and area will be available in about two weeks and that 11 benches for use in the downtown area have been repaired and re-painted in connection with the current "Clean-Up and Paint-Up" campaign. The sum of \$65 for expenses in this drive was voted.

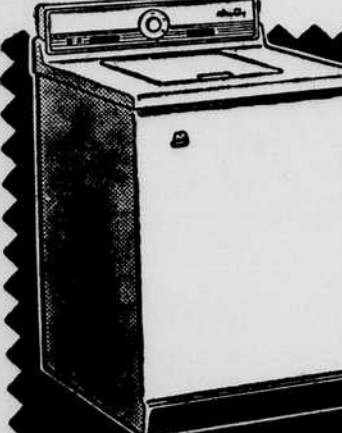

OUR SOJOURN IN TEXAS
(Continued)
Of all the folks that left here for Texas, only a few ever returned.

My brother, C. S. Moffitt, came often on a visit. We never knew anything much about his business. We only knew he was a contractor and builder. He sent Father money regularly, and always brought us younger children nice clothes and other things.

Mark and I were married in 1900. In 1904, C. S. brought his wife and four children here on a month's vacation, also Sherman and his

family came, too. They came on a railroad pass. After they had gone back to Texas, Mark and I decided we'd like to go to Texas.

I wrote to my brother, C. S. I wouldn't write for us to come, but told Sherman to write us to come on. He had sent for some others of our family. They were homesick and blamed him for being out there. So he fixed it so if we were homesick we'd take it out on Sherman instead of him. So we sold everything except our bedding and what we could take as baggage, and were on our way.

We were told if we'd go to Asheville and wait until 1 o'clock in the night and catch the "Vestibule," the fast train, we'd meet connection with the fast trains all the way over there. This was back in 1904, 55 years ago.

We had never been out of the state or any distance from these mountains and had never ridden on a train. We boarded the train in Black Mountain for Asheville.

When we got off the train at the depot in Asheville with our two little children and our hand luggage, it was raining. We hurried into the waiting room, the waiting room was closed. We moved out into the rain.

We left Asheville at 1 o'clock that night (or morning). We arrived in Memphis, Tenn., that night at 9 o'clock. As we stepped off of the train, the conductor said "hurry, hurry, to the transfer. Your train is over yonder waiting for you."

He walked with us out to some kind of a horse-drawn vehicle. I couldn't tell much about it, there wasn't good lights, as we have today. We boarded that vehicle with several others. The driver whipped up those horses and they ran or galloped all the way over there. That was one rough ride. There were several trains standing there. A conductor reached for our tickets. He pointed out everyone's train. When he looked at our tickets he pointed to a train and said "That is your train the Cannonball!"
