There will be open house at the State hospital in Morganton tomorrow (Thursday) from 1 to 4 p.m. with staff members as guides. Visitors will have an opportunity to see the hospital facilities and observe many patient activities. Adults, including high school seniors, are invited.

It is suggested that visitors wear comfortable shoes. This program is in co-operation with nationwide efforts of the Mental Health association to show the public some of the tremendous progress being made in the care and treatment of the mentally ill.

Dr. H. W. Stevens, director of the Buncombe county health department, said that this experience for lay people should make a very positive contribution to public understanding of the needs of mental patients as they leave the community for treatment and as they return for rehabilitation. A special invitation is extended to psychiatric hospital personnel, mental hygiene clinic personnel and all social workers.

### SCHOOL AND... YOUR CHILD

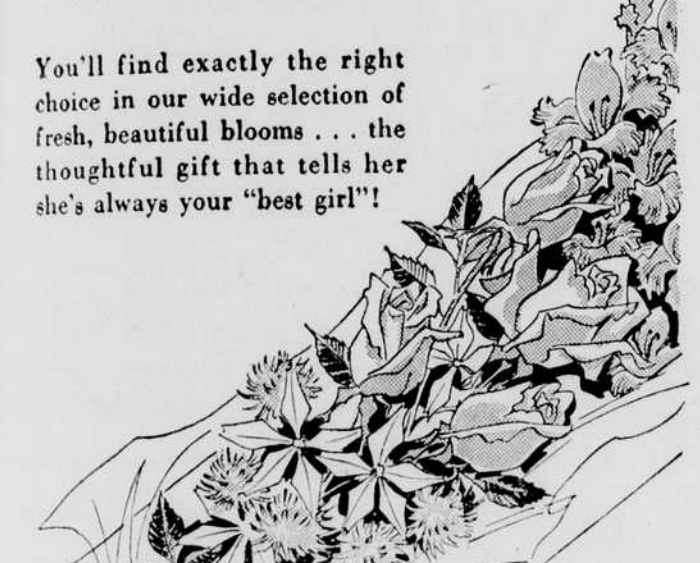

"We with winged Babels, probing space, Annul the ancient need Of hands that shape a home, of plow Of planting seed."

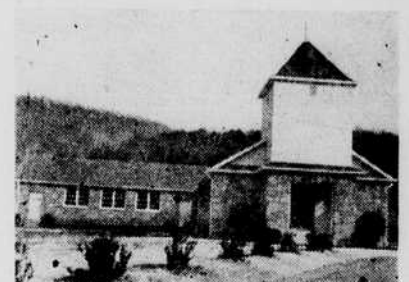
