Total — \$2,500.00

Fifty uniforms will be needed and they will cost \$65.00 each, a total cost of \$3,250.00. If this amount can be raised for uniforms in addition to the budget, then the budget should be adequate to operate without it being necessary to make a special drive for money to purchase uniforms again.

The committee would like for you to study this budget and the need for new uniforms and if it meets with your approval the committee hopes that you will consider including a contribution in your budget each year to support this program and a commitment on the uniforms found for 1960.

For your information, this evening before this letter was written the Lions club of Black Mountain subscribed \$650.00 for uniforms and on last Tuesday evening the Jr. Woman's club of Black Mountain gave \$65.00.

Last year all but two clubs responded and donated to the band and music program.

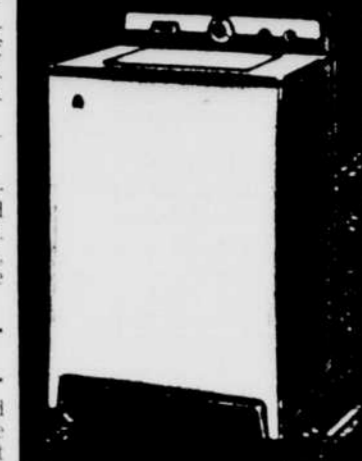
