**CP & L Visions Great Growth**

Demands for electric power in Carolina Power & Light Company's two-state service area are expected to grow to five times last year's demand by 1980.  
 Louis V. Sutton, CP&L president, speaking before the annual stockholder meeting in Raleigh, cited the above figures from a nation-wide power survey released only this week by the Edison Electric Institute in New York City.  
 The survey, based on extensive field studies throughout the nation, predicted power requirements within the next years would increase to four times the 1959 level. Predicted growth for the Southeast, however, placed the 1980 demand at five times the old figure—or 25 per cent greater than the average for the nation as a whole.  
 Sutton said the company will continue building to meet this growing power demand. CP&L estimates a construction budget of \$180,000,000 for the next five years, that would bring the company's post-war expansion expenditures to more than \$432,000,000.
