EXPLAINS ACTION
At a recent meeting of the Black Mountain Chamber of Commerce Mr. Rhodes gave a satisfactory explanation of a situation that had bothered some local citizens since last summer.

You will recall that the organizers of the Fourth of July parade wanted the band to appear and were disappointed when it didn't.

Explaining this, Mr. Rhodes pointed out that the uniforms are cleaned and stored during the summer months, that many of the parents are not too keen on having their sons and daughters participate in activities outside the school, and that the students themselves feel that they are on vacation and don't want to spend the time necessary to practice for an event in the summer or on week-ends.

In fact recently the parents rejected by an overwhelming vote an invitation for the band to participate in a parade in Asheville on a Saturday.

Discussing the coming Christmas parade being sponsored here by the Black Mountain Chamber of Commerce, the director said:

"We feel that our first obligation is to the home community and I'm sure the parents will want to cooperate with the Chamber of Commerce here for the parade which will come on a school day, Friday afternoon, Dec. 2. We will contact the parents regarding this and I believe they will say go ahead."

"But it is not easy for the band to play for events that occur when school is not in session. Many are away on vacation, the uniforms have been cleaned and stored at great expense, the students don't want to give up part of their vacation to practice, and there is the matter of a school organization appearing in an event when school authorities are not in control."

"We want to cooperate but believe our friends will understand why it is not possible to get the band together in the summer."

Mr. Rhodes thanked the community and C. D. Owen of Beacon Manufacturing Co. for the excellent support given in supplying the new uniforms.

The city ordinance which relates to this action states that no one may discharge fire arms within the city limits, anyone violating this law may be fined up to \$50 or given 30 days.

The state law, which is applicable anywhere, inside or outside city limits, says that no firearms may be discharged toward a public road.

So hunters, go where you may kill that for which you are hunting, and let the children play in peace and safety.
