Of the four state-wide bills, one was actually a resolution recognizing the last week in June as Summer Theater Week in North Carolina. The other three concerned an appropriation for Eliada Home, a bill requested by the Asheville Agricultural Development Council to provide for the disposition of dead diseas-

ed poultry on farms with 200 or more fowls; and an amendment to the Community College act of 1957 to permit the community colleges of the state to build a combination classroom-physical education instructional facility.

HARDEST
I met stiff resistance on the community college act all along the line, from the Department of Higher Education to the governor himself.

But after a great deal of leg work, telephone calls to Buncombe, and trips to all the offices in Raleigh we gradually gained support. But the fight was only half won. It went through the House with few questions but the boys were in fine fighting trim in the Senate and almost knocked it out. The vote was 25-19 on second reading, and then a member objected to the third reading, hoping to work during the night to gain support and kill it entirely.

But some fast work by Senator Jim Stikeleather at this point caused the objection to be withdrawn and the bill finally passed. But I didn't breathe easy until the gavel fell and we had adjourned without setting a date for reconvening. Until the last I expected someone to jump up in the Senate and ask that the bill be recalled to the floor.

various colleges so as to be used as reference works. These two lectures were published in the National U.D.C. magazine and the library in Orlando, Fla., requested and was given a copy for its file.

When Mrs. Sharp lived in New York City she was state chairman to promote Sidney Clifton Lanier to the National Hall of Fame in New York University. He had just "lost" to Stephen Foster, as he was not well known in the north and was considered a regional poet. Mrs. Sharp, for five years, wrote articles for the New York papers, quoting his poems, and spoke before many clubs. At the end of that period, at the next "election", Lanier was unanimously chosen.

Mrs. Sharp spoke before the N. C. Archaeology society in Raleigh several years ago, on the "Archaeology of the Mayas and Incas", illustrating her talk with pictures (colored films) taken on her trips to Mexico, Guatemala, and Peru.

When she was president of the Asheville Branch of Pen Women, she organized a branch in New Bern. She also organized the American Artists' Professional League of Asheville of which she is a life-long sponsor.

Locally Mrs. Sharp (Anne Kendrick) is known for her Poet's Corner that ran for a number of years in the Black Mountain NEWS. Under the founder of "The News" she had a weekly "Nature Study" article.

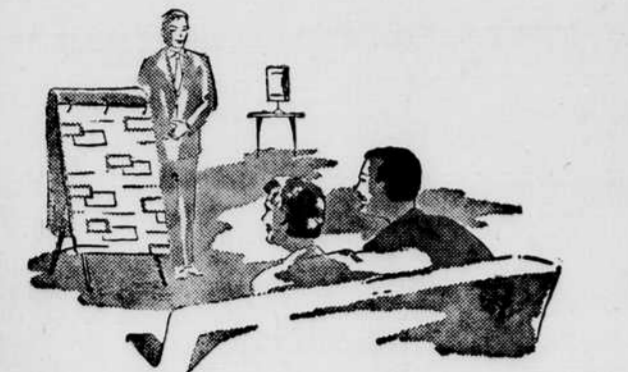
