There should be no profit motive behind the policeman making an arrest, and there certainly should be no profit motive behind the court official getting a conviction.

The court improvement amendment will eliminate this type of operation in North Carolina.

The amendment also provides for division of the state into a convenient number of local court districts by the General Assembly. The General Assembly will prescribe where the District Courts shall sit, with the provision that one must sit in at least one place in each county.
