Nine Million New Phones Are Installed

More telephones were added throughout the world in 1963 than in any previous year. Over nine million additional telephones were placed in service, bringing the world's total up to 159,200,000.

The largest previous gain was in 1959 when 8.8 million telephones were installed.

Japan added more than a million telephones in 1962 and became the third ranking country in total telephones. The United States ranked first with 80,969,000 telephones, followed by the United Kingdom with 8,911,000. Japan had a total of 7,356,007.

The figures were included in the 1963 edition of "The World's Telephones," released today by the American Telephone and Telegraph Company. All figures are as of January 1, 1963, since it takes a year to obtain the data.

India had a greater percentage gain of telephones in 1962 than any other country, but it still ranked last among the 27 countries reporting 500,000 or more telephones. India reported it had 602,630 036 a year earlier. This was a gain of 16.3 per cent. Japan's increase of more than one million telephones was a gain of 15.9 per cent. New York City's 4,798,371 telephones at the beginning of 1963 outranked 20 of the 27 countries in the list.

Countries outside the United States are making rapid gains in new telephones and accounted for 61 per cent of the increase in 1963, compared with 51 per cent ten years earlier. At the beginning of 1963, there were five telephones for every 100 persons in the world. This was a slight rise from the 4.9 telephones per 100 persons reported the previous year.
